FLEXIBLE WORKSPACE...WHAT IS IT?

FLEXIBLE WORKSPACE:

It's a broad term to define how and when work is done – in a way that's most effective for the employee. It can include telecommuting, job sharing, agile-based working (or working in various locations within the office), and compressed/reduced work schedules.




DRIVE BUSINESS SUCCESS



PRODUCTIVITY

Happy employees are on average **15%** more productive.⁵



ENGAGEMENT

74% of senior executives consider employee engagement to be "very important" to achieving organizational success.⁶

A **5%** increase in employee engagement in one year is associated with a 3% increase in revenue growth in the next.⁷



RECRUITMENT/RETENTION

Companies with effective mobile policies are rated **17%** higher by their employees for their ability to attract talented employees.⁸


WHAT'S REQUIRED TO GET STARTED?

COMMITMENT TO EMPLOYEE EXPERIENCE




61% say that working anywhere in the office is important or very important to them.⁴
